Norfolk Island

The Norfolk Island Group is a globally important biodiversity hotspot and has been designated as an 'Important Bird Area' by Birdlife International.

The Norfolk Island group is a breeding site for several 100,000 seabirds including the masked booby, grey ternlet, white tern, sooty tern, & wedge-tailed shearwater. Phillip Island supports one of the largest breeding populations of red-tailed tropic birds in Australia.

Norfolk itself is home to the endemic & endangered Norfolk Island Green Parakeet, & other endemic birds such as the Norfolk Island golden whistler & Norfolk Island scarlet robin.

Norfolk Island Bird Week

Norfolk Island enjoys coastal, wetland, forest and farm environments which all support a great variety of endemic, introduced and migratory birds. A summertime walk along our cliff tops is often rewarded with sightings of White or Sooty terns, Noddies, Masked Boobies or Tropicbirds. More frequent sightings are now thankfully being made in rainforest areas of the endemic and endangered Green Parrot, and across the Island of the Norfolk Island Morepork.

Norfolk Island Bird Week offers 'twitchers' an incredible opportunity to attend presentations by park rangers who are undertaking the hands-on work of securing the Green parrot and other vulnerable species; and join tours led by Margaret Christian, local bird expert and author of "Norfolk Island...the birds" and Dr Derek Ball, Wild Mob Director and Chair of Island Arks Australia.
