

THE NORFOLK ISLAND GROUP

A globally important biodiversity hotspot and renowned breeding site for several 100,000 seabirds — Phillip Island supports one of the largest populations of Red-tailed Tropic Birds in Australia. Its many other habitant seabird species include: the Masked Booby, Grey Ternlet, White Tern, Sooty Tern and Wedge-tailed Shearwater.

A cliff-top walk is rewarded with close sightings of ground nesting seabirds, and for intrepid night explorers, the distinctive call of the Norfolk Morepork and haunting cry of the 'Ghost Bird' (Shearwater).

As one of the few islands in the Pacific founded on a seamount in the warm temperate zone, Norfolk enjoys coastal, wetland, forest and farm environments, all of which support a huge variety of bird fauna. Norfolk Island is home to the endemic and endangered 'Green Parakeet' – now more frequently sighted in rainforest areas due to conservation efforts – and other endemic birds such as the 'Golden Whistler', 'Scarlet Robin' and 'Nuffka' (Sacred Kingfisher).
