Advance Fishing and Cruising / On demand



Spanning over 200 years, the Norfolk Island Cemetery is one of the most important and unique cemeteries in Australasia. This personalised tour will take you on a journey behind the scenes to see the gardens of Bounty Mutineer descendants. Experience a market garden, complete with a flower garden and an orchard and a secluded old Island home surrounded by gardens and irrigated by a handdug, convict-era well. You will also visit the inspirational 'Labour of Love' Garden and the Picturesque Gardens, with amazing views. Begin with a tour of the adjoining *Norfolk Island Cottage Pottery* (est. 1974) with ceramic artists Steve and Alison Ryves and enjoy a throwing demonstration, then stroll around the edible gardens and cheese making facilities to meet and interact with the happy "hilli" goats. "The Norfolk Whey" tour concludes with a invitation into the family homestead. Sit back, relax and take in the beautiful ocean and valley views, all while indulging in the fresh-picked goodness of the farm, as well as Hilli Goat Cheeses, homemade breads, dips and chutneys!

Experience the colourful history and culture of Norfolk's most recent settlement. View magnificent gardens and traditional crops on a visit to an original homestead while riding in Norfolk's first tour couch — a model A Ford. View a film, visit a blacksmith's forge, a WWII Army hut and the Museum of Memorabilia — *incl. light refreshments*.





Set in Convict Stone – Quality Row Heritage Tour (NI History & Genealogy – Personal Island Tours) / Mon & Fri 1pm (approx 3-3.5 hrs) / Adults \$47pp / Kids \$25pp / Min 2

This guided tour of the World Heritage listed 'Kingston Arthur's Vale Historic Area' investigates examples of convict construction, including stunning Georgian buildings. The main hub for all pre-European settlements, during the harsh convict times and after the arrival of the Pitcairn families, this Historic Area is now a living museum. A visit to Norfolk's Cemetery reveals some of the oldest known European memorials, blending in with the graves of executed convicts, murdered military, children of the 'Bounty Mutineers' and modern day burials – *incl. afternoon tea in a private home overlooking the KAVHA site*.

Taste of Norfolk (Baunti Tours) / Tue & Thur 1pm / \$65pp

Visit a local beekeeper's home and see their flow hives and incredible flight paths of the fascinating endemic honeybees. Next stop is a beef and dairy farm, supplying fresh milk and cheese for our market-place, to get a taste of the local beef sausages. Last is a cooking demonstration, where you will learn about traditional Island methods, handed down by our Tahitian fore-mothers. You will meet 3 passionate locals so just sit back, relax and enjoy!



The Music Valley Experience / Mon 9am / \$55pp

Reconnect with nature, listen to our Stories and experience our Culture. Includes a presentation on Cultural heritage, family history and traditions, seasonal fruit tasting, strolling through gardens while learning about weaving, plaiting, endemic plants and the history of this amazing property.

Spend 2 hrs in an air conditioned bus with full audio/visual equipment, visiting various sites that illustrate what early life was like on Norfolk. Your guide, Max Hobbins, will cover subjects including: the whaling industry, ship unloading and ship building on-Island, the Airport's construction in WWII, the Melanesian Mission and many more!





1856 The Untold Story (Baunti Tours) / Tue & Sat 7:30pm / \$55pp

June 8th 1856 marks the arrival of the Pitcairn Islander *Bounty* descendants, aboard the *Morayshire*. 194 people — 40 men, 47 women, 54 boys, and 53 girls — landed in blustery conditions on the recently abandoned penal settlement of Norfolk Island — a frightening testimony of man's inhumanity to man, set aside for the 'worst of the worst' and full of ghosts and memories. Few had been to sea before and after a five week journey of 6,000km (3,700 miles) they were homesick and heartsick. Follow their stories in the World Heritage listed Kingston Area on this 1 hour evocative tour. Baunti Tours brings the past to life with audio aboard their coach, recounting tales of the families, where they lived and how they adapted to their new life.
